Duration

Duration of Study: MBA, Graduate Diploma, Graduate Certificate in Business Administration

UBSS has a unique trimester year, which means that the MBA can be fast-tracked and completed in four trimesters or one and a half years. UBSS has three intakes per year (in early January, May and August) that provide the opportunity for students to commence their studies during the year. Completion times* (full-time mode) are summarised below:
