General Information for Overseas Students

- Students on a Student Visa MUST be enrolled in a full-time course, which means a standard subject load of 4 subjects each trimester totaling 8 subjects per year.
- Textbooks are required to be purchased and should be budgeted for.

If you require accommodation and airport pickup service, you must give us at least 2 weeks advance notice. Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) Fee

The Student's CoE Fee consists of two (2) components mainly:

1. All Providers registered on the Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses (CRICOS) are required, under Section 23 of the Education and Services for Overseas Students Act 2000 (the ESOS Act) and Section 8 of the Education Services for Overseas Students (Registration Charges) Act 1997, to pay an Annual Registration Charge (ARC). The ARC comprises a base fee, a fee for each course registered on CRICOS plus a student enrolment component. This is calculated on the total number of enrolments of overseas students on student visas in each course provided.
2. Administrative and processing costs of maintaining the accuracy and completeness of the Commonwealth Government's Provider Registration and International Students Management System (PRISMS).

CoE Fee:

- If course duration is 2 years, then \$65.00
- If course duration is 3 years, then \$97.50

Students who are approved to have their CoE reduced due to credit transfer, or who are approved to have their CoE extended, will need to pay these CoE fees as part of the approval process. All Fees can be paid by: Credit Card/Debit Card (MasterCard & Visa Only) (in keeping with best industry practices no cash payments will be accepted).
