Incentives Provided by UBSS for Domestic MBA Students

As part of the contribution to COVID-19 recovery, UBSS is offering 100 Bursaries to Executive Delivery Mode MBA students. This further demonstrates the commitment from CEO Alan Manly OAM and the GCA Board to assist postgraduate students with continuous learning, to get that promotion, a new career or launch a new business.

Students studying their MBA via the Executive Delivery Mode are eligible to apply for 1 of 100 COVID-19 Bursaries to make their studies more accessible in the wake of the pandemic. This 80% bursary reduces fees down to \$399 per subject (from \$1,999). As at July 2022 there are currently 50+ students using the scheme – and judging from the ongoing feedback – very much enjoying the course and the delivery mode.

The bursaries are restricted to domestic students only and within the Executive Delivery Mode MBA only.





We are delighted to introduce our Fellows. Our Fellows provide the UBSS student cohort and Alumni with integral 'work integrated learning' (WIL) experiences, by sharing their expertise and business knowledge through interviews, special presentations, case studies and seminars. The value of our Fellows is clearly recognized to create a better tomorrow for today's students.



Can I suggest **everyone** does a practice run recording in your office, and if that recording is suitable we would consider using that version. For others who are outside of Sydney, please do the same and with the view of your recording being your very final.

The required format is: mp4 (1280x720p, non-interlaced, with a minimum bitrate of 5000 kbits/sec)please allow approximately 5 seconds of clear time at top and tail for our ease of editing.

Once you are happy with your version - please send me an email and a dropbox link for collection.

Please appear in full business dress (men: suit and tie), with a nice background, possibly in your office if backdrop is clean and suitable, or something interesting relating to your work, anywhere from 1.30 to 2.30 minutes duration is desirable.

CFE Start-Up / Competition

A new incentive from the Centre for Entrepreneurship, which is a unique competition for UBSS students at the postgraduate level and Alumni of UBSS, focused on acknowledging and awarding innovative and entrepreneurial business plan proposals.

The competition presentations will be from 'individuals', <u>not</u> group participations.

The award categories will include:

Most Innovative Business Concept – something new, something different, something that stands out from the current marketplace, a business and product(s) that will solve numerous problems for customers.

Greatest Social Impact & Sustainability Business Model – something that resolves issues relating to making the world or the community a better place, something that comforts an ongoing concern or awareness in our society, something that is sustainable and resolves any issues about saving the planet.

The 'CFE Start-Up' will be sponsored by UBSS, and co-sponsored by the Institute of Managers & Leaders (IML).

There will be 4 main event judges, 3 UBSS CFE Fellows and 1 IML Fellow representative. We will also require pre-selection judges from our CFE Fellowships to cull-down our initial submissions to 12 select choices. Interested Fellows - please reach out to me asap to express your interest in being a part of the judging process.

The competition will take place during the 2^{nd} week of December with lead up time for the judges to pre-select a couple months prior.

Contest winners will receive an Award Certificate; a discount on one future subject selection at UBSS; complimentary access to an IML Virtual Leadership Workshop; a recommendation letter to a choice of your request; and two 30-minute mentorship sessions with a sought-after business executive associated with IML or an entrepreneur Fellow of the UBSS Centre For Entrepreneurship.

The competition will be held on Zoom and will be streamed live on the UBSS facebook page, the IML facebook page, and via a designated event link.
