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1 Purpose

1.1 Context

UBSS is committed to ensuring its students are provided with the support and resources required to assist them to be successful in their studies.

This policy outlines how UBSS will identify students who are at risk of not successfully completing their units of study and the support available to students to assist them with successfully completing their units of study, including the UBSS 's processes for ensuring that students are aware of these support options.

This policy is published in accordance with the UBSS's obligations under the Higher Education Support Act 2003 (Cth).

2 Scope

2.1 Rationale

UBSS is required to establish a clear policy and set of procedures to support students to successfully complete units of study in which they are enrolled. This policy applies to all students enrolled in an award course at UBSS.

3 Policy Statement

3.1 Students At Risk of Not Successfully Completing Subjects

UBSS actively monitors student progress and identifies those students at risk of not successfully completing their studies, and will contact students based on the following policy:

Academic Progression, Monitoring and Intervention Policy

UBSS communicates with students identified as at risk of not successfully completing their studies to ensure they are informed about and have access to the support services made available.

3.2 Support Services Available to Students

UBSS provides a variety of support services for students to assist in the successful completion of their studies.

Academic Support Services include:

- Academic Monitoring and Intervention Management
- Access to Learning Support Officers: At UBSS, our Learning Support Officers help ensure every student receives tailored support, promoting equitable access to academic resources and enhancing the overall learning experience at UBSS.
- Learning Resources/ Student Central
- Reading Subjects
- Video recordings of class lectures via Moodle
- <u>E-libraries</u>
- <u>MBA TV</u> for subject content support.

Non-Academic Support Services include:

- Wellness Support
- <u>Student Orientations / Student Orientation Policy</u>
- Equity and Diversity



- Diversity, Equity and Inclusion of First Nations Students
- Wellbeing and Safety

UBSS provides information on support services to:

- commencing students as part of their orientation; and
- commencing and continuing students via the University webpages, via email bulletins and other communication media.
